FOREIGN LANGUAGE (ARABIC) TEACHING ASSISTANT FELLOWSHIPS

The United States-Israel Educational Foundation is offering five grants to Israeli citizens whose mother tongue is Arabic and who are teachers or have teaching experience, in support of participation in the 2020/2021 FLTA program. Fellows will teach Arabic at a U.S. academic institution and, in parallel, will take two academic courses per semester. Fellows will also take part in cultural events, language clubs, and language tables.

The Fulbright FLTA Program is a non-degree program for early career English teachers and other professionals. Participants have the opportunity to refine their teaching skills, increase their English language proficiency, and extend their knowledge of the society and culture of the United States while serving as teaching assistants for their native language to U.S. students.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Candidates must obtain a Bachelor degree by June 1, 2020, have teaching experience and a good command of English.
- Dual American-Israeli citizens or permanent residents of the United States are not eligible to apply.
